The Superior General, Father Valdir José De Castro, appointed him in this task with the consent of his Council during the meeting of 2-4 July 2018.

Father Bogusław, 50, is the outgoing Superior of the Poland-Ukraine Region, who guided it for two terms (2012-2018). Born in Bielsko Biąta (Poland) in 1968, he entered the Pauline community of Masłonia on 29 August 1994. Here, on 8 September 1995, he made his first profession, confirming it in perpetuity in Częstochowa four years later. He was ordained a priest in Warsaw on 30 June 2000.

From 1998 to 2009 he carried out his apostolate in the biblical editorial office, for which he was responsible as Director and Editor-in-chief for a decade, first in Warsaw and then in Częstochowa. A mature fruit of this demanding work was the new translation of the Bible into Polish published by our editions, the *Edycja Świętego Pawła*. He is the author of numerous titles, especially for children, some of which have also been translated into different languages. Over the years, he was Master of the Juniors, Vocation Promoter and Regional Vicar, before assuming, as mentioned, the leadership role of his Circumscription. In 2010-2011, he also attended social communication studies and journalism at the Catholic University of Lublin. Passionate about music and a songwriter, he has released some CDs.
